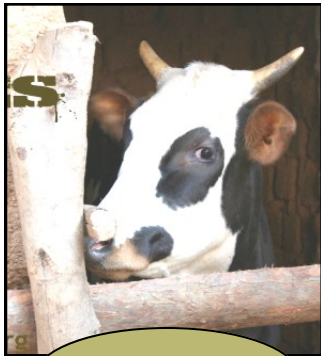

**Burundi**

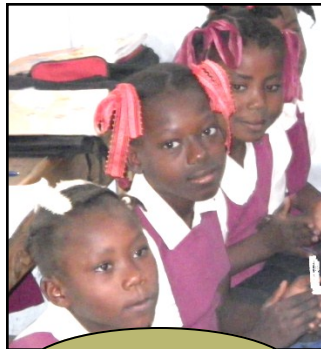
## COW PIES

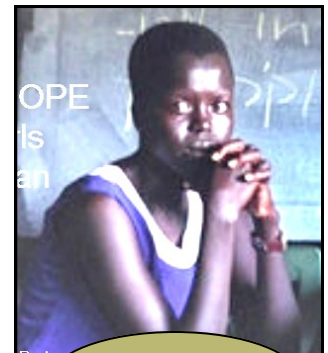
## Hunger-Busting Beans
